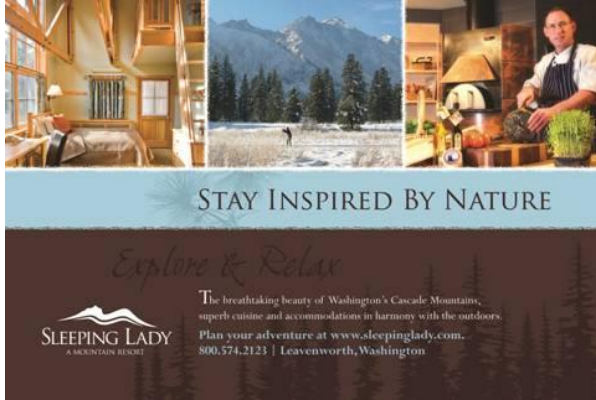

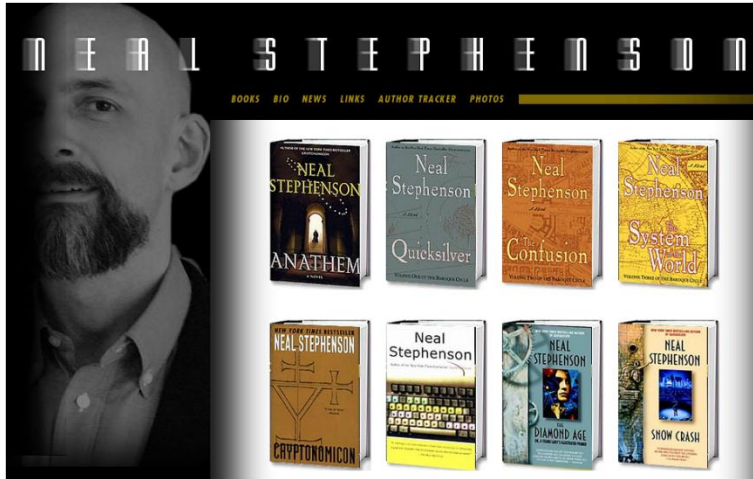

He has been working to advance the understanding and conservation of Orca whales since 1980.

Lunch is provided. It is recommended that the participants stay overnight on the island to increase likelihood of whale sightings.

- Best-selling author of Zodiac, the Big U, Snow Crash, Diamond Age, Cryptonomicon, The Baroque Cycle, Anathem and Reamde.
- Stephenson explores areas such as mathematics, cryptography, philosophy, currency, and the history of science. He also writes non-fiction articles about technology in publications such as Wired.
- He has worked part-time as an advisor for Blue Origin, developing a manned sub-orbital launch system, and is also cofounder of Subutai Corporation, whose first offering is the interactive fiction project The Mongoliad.

Marco Kaltofen

- Marco and Neal Stephenson have traveled from the Volga River in Russia to Ninilchick, Alaska together, now they are hosting a tour of the Columbia River at Hanford.
- Marco Kaltofen is a researcher in the field of radiation fallout at the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Worcester Polytechnic Institute.
- Marco's recent work on hot particles from Fukushima and Hanford is gaining national and international attention. He has also done testing at Los Alamos, the Nevada Test Site, and former Soviet nuclear facilities.
- Marco is also a Hanford Challenge Board member.
